6-301.11	No soap is provided for hand washing in the men's or women's restroom. Soap must be available at all times for handwashing at all hand sinks. Monitor and refill immediately when empty.		10/03/2007
6-301.12	No single use hand towels are available for hand drying at the handsink on the upper level. Single use hand towels are required to be available at all times at all hand sinks. Monitor and refill immediately when empty.		10/03/2007
5-202.11	There is no backflow preventer installed on the mop sink. The large black tube is not approved to be used and cannot be connected to the faucet head because it does not provide adequate backflow prevention. A backflow preventer is required to prevent the backflow of waste water back into the water supply. Remove the large black tube and the duct tape. Install a backflow preventer on the faucet before connecting any kind of hose to the mop sink.		10/17/2007
6-501.111	There are many mouse droppings in the food closet and underneath the sink and inside the drawers on the upper level. Clean up all the mouse droppings and sanitize the areas so that you can monitor if any more mice activity exists. Contact a professional pest control company and have them come out to set traps and to record activity. Have the pest control company come as often as necessary per month to eliminate the pests. Have the pest control company provide you with a receipt or invoice stating what was done and what kind of activity exists. Have this documentation available for MHD upon request. Failure to provide pest control and eliminate mice activity may result in a food license suspension.		10/03/2007

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Notes: If planning on relocating food storage area, ensure that the area is clean and is not underneath any kind of chemicals or waste drains. The food must be elevated on shelves that are at least 6" off of the ground and stored in an area not easily contaminated by grease, dust, or chemical residues.
