2-301.14	Observed an employee putting on gloves without washing hands. Hands must be washed and dried immediately before putting on gloves and immediately after taking gloves off. Instruct all employees the proper procedure for hand washing before using gloves.	\$0.00	02/07/2008
4-601.11	The ice scoop in use at the ice machine was being stored on a dirty tray. The ice scoop also old debris on the underside of the scoop. All food contact equipment/utensils must be clean and be sanitized before use. Clean and sanitize the ice scoop and provide a smooth and cleanable tray to store the ice scoop on between use.		02/07/2008
5-103.11	The water pressure at the hand sink in the women's restroom is not adequate. Repair or replace the faucet so that water can flow freely.		02/07/2008
3-304.12	A squeeze bottle of sauce is being stored on top of chopped onions in the prep cooler. The outside of the squeeze bottle is touching the chopped onions. Remove the squeeze bottle immediately and find a designated location (that does not pose a contamination) to store the squeeze bottle between use.		02/07/2008
4-101.11	Raw food is being stored in a "humour" ice cream freezer. Open foods are also being stored in an upright "true" bottle cooler. Owner states that the reach in cooler and freezer are not functioning and are in the process of being repaired. The "humour" freezer and the "true" cooler are not approved for storing raw and opened foods, however, cold hold temperatures of the food are in compliance. Repair the broken approved coolers and freezers and discontinue storing food in the unapproved cooler and freezer.		02/21/2008

Remove the cardboard underneath the single burner.

Remove the wood piece underneath the beverage dispenser. Unsealed wood is not approved to be used in the kitchen.

Repair the wall paper damage in the hallway to the restroom.

Provide test strips for testing sanitizer concentration.

Repair the leak at the hand wash sink drain.

Remove all unused and/or broken equipment in the back kitchen and storage area.
