3-501.16(A)(2)	Garlic in oil mixture is left out at room temperature. Garlic in oil mixtures are considered potentially hazardous and must be temperature controlled. Keep stored at 41 degrees or less.	04/12/2007
3-302.11(A)(1)	Pan of packaged raw steaks stored inside bucket directly over opened container of pickles in the walk-in cooler. Even though the raw food is sealed and stored inside another container, always store raw foods below ready-to-eat foods.	04/12/2007
4-602.11	Slicer had old food debris which has accumulated underneath the blade area. After use, the entire slicer must be taken apart, cleaned and sanitized.	04/12/2007
2-401.11	Open beverage container was stored above food on the rack in the back oven area. Employee's may have beverages in the kitchen provided that they are covered and not stored in a manner which could contaminate food or equipment. Keep beverages covered with lids.	04/12/2007
6-301.11	No handsoap available at the handwash sink near the exit door. Provide handsoap at all handwash sinks at all times.	04/12/2007
5-103.11	No cold water available at the 2 compartment sink. Restore water to this sink. Repair any leaks as necessary. All sinks must have both hot and cold running water under pressure.	04/12/2007
