Code Number	Description of Violation	Correct By
6-301.12	The hand sink in the back near the warewash sinks is not supplied with any single use hand towels. Single use hand towels are required to be supplied at all hand sinks. Monitor and refill all towel dispensers at all handsinks immediately when empty.	11/16/2007
4-501.11	The sink in the women's restroom is no longer secured to the wall. Secure the sink to the wall and caulk as needed to seal all gaps at the sink/wall junction. The handsink in the back area is leaking from the faucet base. Repair/replace the handsink so that the faucet base no longer leaks.	11/16/2007
4-501.116	The sanitizer sink at the ware wash sinks did not contain the correct concentration of sanitizer. Provide test strips for testing the concentration of the sanitizer before sanitizing utensils/equipment. The concentration of quat ammonium is required to be at 200ppm. Ensure that the correct concentration is present before sanitizing.	11/16/2007
5-202.11	The air gap on the food sink is not properly installed. The food sink drain cannot enter into the funnel in the floor drain. Have a plumber remove enough piping to provide an air gap for the food sink drain. This will prevent waste/sewage contamination in the case of a backup. **The end of the drain cannot enter into the funnel at any point** Ensure that there is an air gap on the soda dispenser ice drain. I was unable to get into the cabinets underneath the soda dispenser. The same principle applies to the soda machine ice drain as the food sink.	11/16/2007



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2-301.12 Observed an employee putting on gloves and preparing food without washing hands. 11/16/2007
Hands are required to be washed immediately before putting on gloves and after taking gloves off. Hands are also required to be washed when switching between tasks that can cause contamination; such as that of handling money. Instruct all employees of the proper procedures and times when hand washing is required.

Inspection Notes

Notes: The women's restroom needs to be rescured to the wall and both sinks in both restrooms need to be recaulked to the wall. There are no teststrips on site for testing the sanitizer. The concentration is still too strong. Instruct all employees that they cannot put on or use gloves without handwashing. They must wash their hands prior to putting on gloves and immediately after taking gloves off. If this plan cannot be followed, there is to be one employee making the food and a second employee handling the register. The food prep sink is not to be used as a dumpsink or to be used to rinse equipment. All equipment and utensils are to be washed in the back warewash sinks. Have employees monitor all handsinks for soap and towel availabilty. Refill immediately when empty.
