4-501.11	A) Walk-in freezer is dripping condensate forming an ice mound directly on food boxes. B) Exit doors from back of store are not sealed properly, install new weather stripping to prevent pest entry.	7/14/2016
5-203.13	A) Service Sink. Mop sink was inaccessible at time of inspection. At least 1 service sink or 1 curbed cleaning facility equipped with a floor drain shall be provided and conveniently located for the cleaning of mops or similar wet floor cleaning tools and for the disposal of mop water and similar liquid waste. Keep path to mop sink cleared at all times. B) 6-501.16 Drying Mops. Mop stored directly on floor near restrooms, bucket of stagnant water left in back store room. After use, mops shall be placed in a position that allows them to air-dry without soiling walls, EQUIPMENT, or supplies.	7/14/2016

7-301.11 Food items stored on shelves below or directly adjacent to toxic items. 7/14/2016  
A) Lollipops in customer isle were stored directly below glue and other liquid toxins.  
B) Baby food squeezable carrots stored directly adjacent to bubble bath.  
Poisonous or toxic materials must be kept separate or below food.  
Move food items away from toxins.
