Code Number	Description of Violation	Correct By
2-102.11	Employee stated that they wash the coffee pots in the sink next to the coffee machine. All utensils/equipment must be washed in the 4 compartment sink and must be washed, rinsed, sanitized, and air dried. Instruct all employees on the proper warewash procedure.	11/6/2008
3-101.11	A container of sour cream and various milk beverages are expired in the display cooler. Expired Grade A products may not be displayed for sale. Remove the expired products immediately.	11/6/2008
3-302.11	Raw bacon and raw shelled eggs are stored above milk and gallons of water in the display cooler. All raw animal products must be stored below and/or away from all ready to eat products and beverage containers. Move the raw bacon and the raw shelled eggs below the bottled beverages.	11/6/2008
3-602.11	The bagged ice in the reach in display freezer is not properly labeled. All ice bagged on site must be labeled with the name, address, and contact information of the store. Properly label all bagged ice.	11/6/2008
4-601.11	There is paint and brushes present inside the prewash and rinse sink basins of the 4 compartment warewash sink. These sinks must be kept clean at all times. Clean and sanitize the sink and the sink drainboards and maintain them clean at all times.	11/6/2008



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5-202.11 The wash basin of the 4 compartment warewash sinks is not draining. Have a licensed plumber repair the sink drain so that waste water is able to drain. 11/6/2008

- Notes:**
- Employee stated that they bag ice using milk crates and/or using the dolly in the back storage area. Provide a stainless steel table or a durable, smooth and cleanable rolling cart for bagging the ice.
 - Set up sanitizer buckets for wiping down coffee or slushy spills. All wet rags are to be placed in these sanitizer buckets between use.
 - Remove the bike, the paint, and the lawnmower from the kitchen area. Clean and organize the kitchen area.
