3-302.11	A bucket with raw chicken pieces inside is being stored above ready to eat foods in the walk-in cooler. All food must be protected from cross-contamination. Always store raw foods below ready to eat foods.	4/9/2009
3-501.13	Boxes of frozen shrimp and chicken are being thawed out at room temperature. Thaw foods in a refrigerator or under cold running water. Do not thaw at room temperature.	4/9/2009
4-602.11	The cabbage shredding machine was not cleaned after use. Dried food was evident on the inside surfaces. Food-contact surfaces and utensils must be cleaned as required.	4/9/2009
