Code Number	Description of Violation	Correct By
4-301.16	Employee is washing tomatoes directly in the prewash compartment of the warewash sinks and is slicing the tomatoes on the "dirty" end drainboard. Discontinue washing/rinsing food at the warewash sinks. When washing/rinsing food or preparing food products, the food preparation sink in the back must be used. Instruct all employees on the proper sinks to use when washing/rinsing food.	9/4/2008
	**The warewash sinks are to be used only for washing dishes/equipment. The left side is the dirty side and the right side is the clean side.**	
4-602.11	There is a buildup of a black substance on the metal plate located inside the large ice machine. This plate, as well as the interior of the ice machine, must be cleaned as often as necessary to prevent any buildup of debris/substance. Clean and maintain clean the interior surfaces of the ice machine.	9/4/2008
	The large filter in the back area near the soda boxes is due to be changed. Monitor and change the filters as stated by manufacturer. Be sure to date the new filters as they are installed.	



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5-205.11                      The small handwash sink located next to the food preparation sink is being blocked by a mop bucket and a bottle of chemical cleaner is present inside the sink basin. The hand wash sink must be kept clear of all obstructions at all times and be available for use when needed. Discontinue storing items in the sink basin and keep the hand wash sink unobstructed at all times.                      9/4/2008

**\*\*Move the hand towel dispenser from above the food preparation sink and install it above the small handwash sink.\*\***

**Notes:**

Be sure that the waste drain for the ice machine is always positioned up above the floor drain cover. A physical gap must be present at all times.
