Have the soap dispenser moved to the far right or installed above the sink basin farthest to the right. This basin is the only basin where hand washing is permitted.

When washing or rinsing fruits and vegetables, use the sink basin farthest to the left. This basin is the cleanest basin. Remember to use a colander to place the food items in - never directly place any food item into the bare sink basin.

When washing utensils and equipment, the farthest right sink is to always be left open. This is the prewash or scrape sink. This sink is also used as the hand wash sink so it needs to always be available. The next sink is to be filled with water and soap. The next sink is to be filled with clear water for rinsing. The basin farthest to the left is to be filled with sanitizer. Be sure that the sanitizer is the correct strength before sanitizing utensils/equipment. These three steps, wash, rinse, and sanitize, must be followed each time a utensil/equipment is washed.
