Code Number	Description of Violation	Correct By
3-501.17	Remaining portions of ready to eat meat and other potentially hazardous, ready to eat food in the walk in cooler are not datemarked. Ready-to-eat potentially hazardous food held for more than 24 hours must be clearly marked to indicate the day by which the food is to be consumed on the premise, sold, or discarded. These food products must be discarded or consumed after 7 days. Instruct all employees on the proper datemarking procedure and ensure that the procedure is applied as required.	7/25/2008
4-501.11	The water heater near the coffee dispenser appears to be leaking. Have the water heater serviced and repaired so that it no longer leaks.	8/8/2008
4-601.11	The interior surfaces of both hoods have an accumulation of dust. A few of the filters also show dust accumulation. The hood must be cleaned as often as necessary to prevent dust accumulation. Clean and maintain clean the interior hood surfaces.	7/25/2008
5-202.11	The sprayer arm connection at the 4 compartment warewash sink is leaking water onto the floor. Have the connection repaired by a licensed plumber to code and ensure that it no longer leaks.	8/8/2008



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6-501.12

The wall near the entrance to the warewash room is damaged. Have the wall properly repaired to code. Install base coving at the wall/floor junction to create a tight, gapless seal.

7/25/2008

The floor underneath the ice cream freezer is dirty with trash and other misc. items. Clean the floor and maintain it clean at all times.

Notes:

Handwash sinks are to be used for only hand washing. Do not rinse or store dirty knives in the hand wash sink basin.

Personal employee beverages must be stored below and away from all kitchen/establishment food. Designate an area for all personal food and beverages.
