6-501.114	1. The back door does not have adequate weather stripping to prevent the entrance of pests. Provide weatherstripping for bottom of the door. 2. Employee's coat and purse were stored on top of the cake decorating table. Properly store all employee clothing so it does not contaminate food or food equipment.	4/7/2010
